One of the world's oldest sweeteners, black mission fig, imparts subtle flavors and historical context to our handcrafted Rye Whiskey, honoring the extraordinary history of the Field Museum—and the city of Chicago.

Black Mission Fig is soaked for three months in Journeyman's Last Feather Rye to produce this historic whiskey. Part of Journeyman's Field Spirits collection, Field Rye utilizes ingredients introduced at the 1893 World's Columbian Exposition in Chicago—the same year the museum originated.

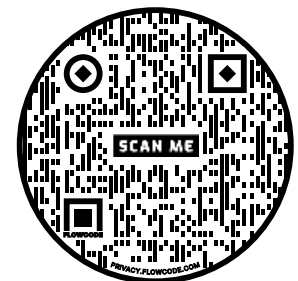
